BALLET BELLEVUE PRESENTS SPRING REPERTOIRE ON CAPITOL HILL

Seattle, WA - Ballet Bellevue Artistic Director Ronn Tice, brings the Eastside's premier dance company's 6th season spring repertoire to Seattle's Broadway Performance Hall on March 23rd and 24th, 2001. Two evening performances and a Saturday matinee of contemporary ballet feature 21st Century dance from Europe and North America.

The program consists of four exciting works.

"Sophies Delight" by Dutch choreographer Ed Wubbe is a mesmerizing work with a haunting original score by Harry de Witt that tells of the discovery of ancient Troy by the German archaeologist Schliemann and his wife, Sofie.

"Missing You" by Keith Derrick-Randolph of Scapino Ballet Rotterdam portrays a gathering of angels.

"Fervour" by Ronn Tice and New York composer Kevin Harkins, a Seattle native, is a confuring of Venus in the stages of a man's life.

"Serenade," a world premiere classical ballet by Ronn Tice to the music of British composer Malcolm Arnold.
